Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) Road Show Stops planned in Loveland and Pueblo



Focus: Stakeholder engagement and public outreach

Audience: Emergency response (fire, law, EMS, haz mat) and hospital personnel, local elected and appointed officials (invited); state public safety and environmental health officials, dispatch, emergency management, public works, coroners, medical examiners, crime scene investigators, military, *or anyone interested in learning more about radiological materials in transportation.*

- **Presentation by US Dept. of Energy:** Brief history since the WIPP opened, successes, amount of waste transported, Rocky Flats Environment Technology Site closure completed because of WIPP, two 2014 accidents at the WIPP, safety improvements made at the WIPP, measures taken to reopen the WIPP facility, any other substantial changes and improvements, followed by a Q&A.
- **Viewing time** of the WIPP Transporter, the Type B cask, and discussion with DOE officials and drivers
