I. Purpose:

- A. To address AJCHRA liability and insurance.

II. Guideline:

- A. The Board and its officers, directors and members shall be indemnified pursuant to the provisions of the Governmental Immunity Act (Part 10 of Article 24 CRS...). The Board may purchase insurance to provide coverage for the Board and its officers, directors and members against any suit or action. Which may be brought against said Board or its officers, directors or members involving or pertaining to any of their acts or duties performed or omitted in good faith for the Board. The Board will maintain insurance on the employees, vehicles and equipment belonging to the Authority.

- B. The member agencies acknowledge that the provisions of Section 29-5-108 C.R.S. concerning liability of a requesting jurisdiction and Section 29-5-109 C.R.S. concerning worker's compensation coverage shall apply to those situations when personnel assistance is requested in response to a hazardous material incident. The member agencies shall provide appropriate liability insurance protection and worker's compensation coverage as determined by the legislative authority of that jurisdiction.
