I. Purpose:

- A. To define Emergency Response Planning for the AJCHRA.

II. Guideline:

- A. Pre-Incident or Emergency Response Planning of known hazardous materials locations and/or facilities is generally the responsibility of the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) as not all locations are required to have complex or detailed response plans.
- B. Pre-Incident or Emergency Response Planning of many facilities has been addressed within the Adams, the Broomfield and the Jefferson County Local Emergency Response Plans and are documented as required for Risk Management Plan (RMP) facilities, Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards (CFATS) facilities and some Tier II facilities under S.A.R.A. Title III.
 - 1. Copies of these plans may be on file at the Emergency Management Units of the respective counties as well as with some local Designated Emergency Response Authority (D.E.R.A.) agencies within the cities and counties.
 - a) The plans typically outline features such as: the geographic features of the response area, the agencies that respond, and the general hazards within the response area, specific locations of those hazards, staging locations, points of access/egress and 24 hour emergency contact information.
 - 2. The AJCHRA supports these planning activities and encourages AHJs to develop facility/location specific Emergency Response Plans using resources such as MARPLOT and CAMEO.
 - a) AJCHRA will assist in the development of these plans when appropriate and requested.
